How delegates are elected for the 2024 presidential nominating process

Must conform with the National Party's rules.

Ensure we educate the general public on how to participate in the process (Delegate or Standing Committee member)

GOAL: Maximize the greatest participation in the process



What is a Delegate?

Role of a Delegate is to:

- Represent DC at the DNC National Convention
- Select the party's nominee for President
- Adopt a statement of party principles and goals known as the party platform
- Adopt the rules for the party's activities, including the presidential nominating process.



Important Dates

Date	Event
March 1	Appoint DC Affirmative Action Committee and submit a Letter of Intent to DNC Rules & Bylaws Committee
March 2	Draft Plan available for Public Comment (30-day public comment requirement)
April 2	Deadline to Submit Comments
May 2	DCDSC Vote on Delegation Plan
May 3	Submit final DC 2024 Delegation Plan to the DNC
Sept-Dec	Educate Public on Delegate Process

How many delegates are there?

2024: 45 delegates and 2 alternates

- 13 District-Level Delegates & 1 Alternate
- 2 Pledged Party Leader and Elected Official (PLEO)
- 4 At-Large & 1 Alternate
- 28 Automatic Delegates



District-Level Delegate

Open to all District residents who are registered to vote as Democrat

Pre-Primary Election – 2024

13 elected, 1 alternate

At-Large Delegates

- 4 At-Large Delegates; 1 Alternate
- DC registered Democrat
- **Elected by the members of the DC Democratic State Committee**
- Presidential nominee has the right to remove candidate(s) to ensure support



Party Leader & Elected Officials

2 Delegate positions

Elected Member of the DC Democratic State Committee

Elected Official in the District of Columbia – Democrat

Elected by the members of the DC Democratic State Committee

- Presidential Nominee has the right of remove candidates to ensure support



Automatic Delegates

Members of the DNC who live in the District of Columbia

Delegate to Congress and Shadow Senators

Mayor



Other Opportunities – Temporary Standing Committee

Temporarily elected by the DC Democratic State Committee to serve on one of three DNC Standing Committees until the permanent members are seated

Rules

- Provide oversight on rules governing the structure and procedures of the DNC Convention

Credentials

- Provide oversight on DNC Convention credential distribution to delegates and notable guest

Platform

- Every four years, Democrats from across the country join together to craft our party's platform. The platform is created to uplift working people and write out the values that will guide our party for years to come.

Permanent members are selected by the Presidential Nominee
